Racing Classes for 2005 season

Juniors: Junior 85cc 11-15yrs, Junior 125cc 2 stroke / 250 four stroke 13-15yrs.

Seniors: A Grade, B Grade + C Grade, Over 35 Expert, Over 35 Clubman, Over 45's.

Points are awarded at each round and go to yearly MX and Enduro point scores in each class. You must work or provide a worker for at least one round to get 100 work rule points. The winner of a round gets 25 points, so 100 work points are important for your total.

Sign on at all race days is 8:00am to 9:00am, make sure that you check the message bank before any event for last minute changes.

- OBMCC Membership application forms are available on the website, at a general meeting, or at a race day. When your membership is approved at the next general meeting you will be sent your riding number and an MNSW affiliation card, which you need to get a racing licence. Applications for MNSW licences are available on the website, at a general meeting, at a race day or call MNSW on: 9635 9177. The MNSW application has a theory test to be completed. A practical riding test is also compulsory.
